V. Democratic Principles

- Merging District 2 and 3 discussion is brought back up by President school, HV Jenkins, Dawson James
 - North and South Representatives
 - We should have a transition year
 - At this years convention, District 2 and 3 should meet in the same space and the current District Representatives will facilitate the conversation
 - Explaining one unified district in the south
 - One school to represent each region
 - Rockdale will be allowed to attend District 1
 - Augusta schools will most likely go to Savannah
 - Should district 2 continue emailing people in District 2 for running
 - If there are multiple people wanting to run, a dual position could be considered
 - Motion: Communications (Meadowcreek) moved to combine District 2 and 3 together
 - District 2 Representatives (West forsyth) seconded the motion
 - Motion carried
 - Amendment proposals requests should be added to a different email from Parli

- Assistant Executive Director Corey Stillwell
 - Legacy Youth Leadership 4 track free programs funded by corporate donors.
 - Prioritization, Ethical storytelling, Money track, & Vote track
 - Partnership with Legacy Youth Leadership
 - 2 hour seminar
 - 3 students from each school at convention will get to attend a
 Voting extended workshop
 - 2 kids in work2bewell and 3 kids to LYL
 - Workshop will not be political, but rather the power of your vote, history, impacts of voting, and the connection to student council elections
 - Legacy Youth Leadership is born out of the Thirst Project (clean water to other countries)
 - They will go out to your school and do free presentations for your school
 - Activity based
 - 150-200 students, ideally
 - Voice track could be used at BLAST!
 - Professional learning for our delegation
- Executive Director Laura Droms
 - Proposed Constitutional Amendments

- Must be submitted in writing to the Parli & Executive Director 4 weeks prior to convention (Jan. 24th)
 - Cannot accept a constitutional amendment after Jan. 24th
- Must be sent to all member schools along with the author's name and contact info 2 weeks prior to convention (Feb. 7th)
- Anyone speaking against must register to speak against at registration of convention
 - Sign-up sheet for anyone speaking against
 - They cannot speak from the floor if they did not sign up prior
- Are there any areas we need to address/amend?
 - Read the constitution for areas of weakness and any changes that could be made
 - Parli should compare the old and new constitution to review changes that need to be updated
- Legally bound to have a board of directors, could lose 501C3
 - Board of directors is currently made up of current Executive Director and 2 previous Executive Directors
 - Since Droms has served for 12 years, it would be ineffective and unreflective of our board
 - GASC Previous Board of Directors given oversight, cannot hire and fire
 - Droms should be on the board, made up of 4 people in addition to Droms

- 1 Executive Director
- 1 previous Executive Director
- 1 Community Member
- 1 Advisor
- 1 previous student (GASC alumni)
- Panel of people, appointments would have to be approved
- Serve for a term of 3 years, but with no term limit
- Staggered terms or all at once?
 - Does not have to be decided until now, but must be decided by 4:00PM
 - Meet in January 2025 for a state organization meeting, they would have oversight on the budget and provide direction/advice
- Amendment to take place this year before the reelection of the Executive Director to make the term a 4 year term (Corey Stillwell)
 - Staggered term with the Advisor Liaison (2 year terms)
 - Odd and even years of election
 - If you would want to propose the amendment email to
 Corey for help in constructing it, to be sent to Parli
 - GSMST would like to propose the amendment
- Election Committee

- Committee Make-up
 - District Reps UNLESS they are running for office. If a
 District Rep school is running for office, please let us know
 as soon as possible so Parli can recruit a different school
 from your district.
 - One student and adult rep from district
 - Houston County will most likely be on the election committee for District 2
- Responsibilities
 - Assist in the election meeting, approving campaign materials, previewing skits & reading/previewing speeches
 - Managing clock and warnings for all timed elements of campaigning
 - Serving as Tally Clerks
 - Overseeing District elections/campaigning for their district
- Eboard Elections
 - Recruit for board positions!
 - Letters are due by Jan. 24th (18 days to go!)
 - Droms and Parli
- District Rep Elections
 - Recruit!!! The best way to recruit is by simply encouraging a school to take a chance!
 - Except for District 2, not too aggressive
